Conditions for the Sale and Consumption of Alcohol

The supply of, sale of and consumption of alcohol are all subject to strict legal controls.

It is, therefore, a **strict condition of booking** that the Hirer meets **all legal requirements** regarding the supply of and consumption of alcohol.

The Hirer **MUST**, therefore, ensure that

- All alcoholic drinks are purchased on site.
- No private supplies of alcohol are brought onto or consumed on the premises either by organisers or guests (except when authorised by the FCA and on payment of a corkage fee).
- **Only persons aged 18 years or over** are allowed to consume alcohol.
- **Any person who looks under the age of 25, whose age is not known to the supplier of alcohol, is to provide evidence of their age before being permitted to purchase or consume alcohol.**
- Alcohol is not offered for sale to any person under the influence of alcohol.
- Alcohol is only consumed inside the building.
- There are no irresponsible promotions of alcohol consumption.

We will ensure that: (1) Free drinking water is available, and
 (2) Alcohol in small measures is available.

Any form of alcohol offered as part of any 'ticket price' counts as the sale of alcohol, and is therefore covered by the provisions of the Licensing Act

If there are any doubts, the hirer should discuss it with the Bookings Secretary and/or seek advice from the Licensing Department of Stroud District Council.

The Hirer should, **without exception**, consult the Bookings Secretary beforehand to discuss the consumption of alcohol at the function, and any specific requirements (champagne, wine with a meal, etc).

There is a £10 charge for the use of a bar.

If a change to the existing licensing conditions (time or location) is required, there will be an additional charge of £21. A minimum of 3 weeks notice is required for licence alterations.
